IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, especially when children are present, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING.

KEEP AWAY FROM WATER.

DANGER

As with most electrical appliances, electrical parts are electrically live even when switch is off.

To reduce the risk of death by electric shock:

- Always unplug this appliance from the electrical outlet immediately after using.
- Do not use while bathing or in the shower.
- Do not place or store this appliance where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- Do not place in or drop into water or other liquid.
- If an appliance falls into water, "unplug it" immediately. Do not reach into the water.
- Unplug this appliance before cleaning it.

WARNING

To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electric shock or injury to persons:

- An appliance should never be left unattended when it is plugged in.

- Never drop or insert any object into any of the appliance's openings.

- Do not use an extension cord.
- This appliance is hot when in use. Do not let eyes or bare skin touch heated surfaces.

- Do not place the heated unit directly on any surface while it is hot or plugged in.
- The plug on this appliance has one blade wider than the other, it is a polarized plug. As a safety feature, this plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.
- Always store this appliance and cord in a moisture-free area. Do not store it in temperatures exceeding 140°F (60°C).
- This appliance is for household use only.
- Do not plug or unplug this appliance when your hands are wet.





PRODUCT FEATURES

Thank you for purchasing this Remington® 2 in 1 Straightener. Please carefully read the instructions contained in this booklet, and keep them in a safe place for future reference.

- Ceramic titanium coated plates
- On-off switch
- Heat Control Sensor dial
- Temperature display
- Cool tips
- Hinge lock
- Swivel cord
- Micro guide combs



ADDITIONAL FEATURES

- Fast heat up: ready to use in 30 seconds.
- Automatic safety shut off: this unit will switch itself off if no button is pressed or it is left on after 60 minutes.

HOW TO USE

- Before use, ensure the hair is clean, dry and tangle-free.
 - Section the hair prior to styling. Style the lower layers first.
- Press and hold the on/off button to switch on.
 - To activate Heat Control Sensor twist and hold the temperature dial all the way to the right for 2 seconds. The numbers/digits are illuminated blue for normal function and will change to red, reading "HC" when the sensor is activated. To turn off, twist and hold the temperature dial all the way to the right again. The temperature display will change back to original color.
 - Select the appropriate temperature for your hair type. To increase or decrease the temperature, twist the temperature control left ◀ or right ▶ then release it. As you twist the temperature control the temperature will be displayed on the temperature display.
- IMPORTANT:** If you do not move the temperature control again for 5 seconds, the currently selected temperature will be automatically locked (the lock symbol will appear in the display). This is to prevent you from accidentally changing the temperature during styling. Once locked, if you want to change the temperature you must twist and hold the temperature control either to the left ◀ or right ▶ and hold it there for 2 seconds. You can then change the temperature as desired.
- The temperature display will stop flashing when the appliance is ready to use.

Temperature	Hair type
300°F - 340°F (150°C - 170°C)	Thin/fine, damaged or bleached hair
340°F - 410°F (170°C - 210°C)	Normal, healthy hair
410°F - 450°F (210°C - 230°C)	Thick and difficult-to-style hair

HOW TO USE (CONTINUED)

Smooth Straight:

Tip: Section hair into manageable sections and spray with desired pre-styling products.

1. Take a 2 inch section of hair and place it between the plates near to the roots.
2. Close the plates and steadily glide down the entire length of the hair without stopping.
3. Repeat this around the head.

Smooth Straight



Beachy Waves or Bouncy Curls

Style	Section Width	Movement Speed
Bouncy Curl	¾ inch (2 cm)	Very Slow
Soft Wave	1½ inch (4 cm)	Slow

The type of curl depends on size of section, speed at which you move the tool down the hair, and how much and the direction you twist.

Toward face



Away from face



Beachy Waves:

1. Clamp a 1"-1.5" size section of hair between plates near the roots. Rotate styler 180° and slowly glide down the remaining section in this position without stopping.
2. Remove the appliance and brush/comb through curl to loosen. Breaking up curls before they're fully cooled will loosen even further.
3. Repeat this around the entire head to create as many curls as desired.
4. Brush or finger comb through hair to loosen up curls if needed.

Beachy Waves



Bouncy Curls:

1. Clamp a .75-1" size section of hair between plates near the roots. Close plates and rotate styler 180° and glide down very slowly, continuing to twist if desired, without stopping.
2. Remove the appliance and allows curls to spring into shape.
3. Repeat this around the entire head to create as many curls as desired.
4. Allow hair to cool for longer lasting results

Bouncy Curls



Tips:

- Spray with desired pre and post styling products
- Section hair into manageable sections before styling
- Grip cool tip ends to help keep plates closed when gliding down sections
- Alternate twisting 180° away from your face and towards your face for a more undone, beachy look.
- Twisting all the curls away from your face will give a more polished, consistent curl result.
- You can hold the styler however feels comfortable

Memory Function

- Each time you use the product it will automatically set itself to the last temperature used.

STORAGE

Let the appliance cool down before cleaning and storing.

The plates can be locked together for easy storage: To lock, close the plates and slide the hinge lock to the locked  position. To unlock, slide the hinge lock to the unlocked  position. **NOTE:** Do not heat the unit in the locked position.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Unplug the appliance and allow to cool.
- Wipe all the surfaces with a damp cloth.
- Don't use harsh or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.

Never wrap the cord around the appliance, since this will cause the cord to wear prematurely and break, thus voiding warranty. Handle the cord carefully and avoid jerking, twisting, or straining it, especially at plug connections.
